5	Eligibility	Hut not exceeding 300 sq.ft. or 27.85 sq.mt. with mud-wall / brick wall or thatched wall and thatched roof only. Hut does not include farm huts.
6	Criteria for the eligibility	OHOB is applicable also for house constructed for economically weaker sections under the “Chief Minister’s 5000 Houses Programme” and houses constructed by the District Rural Development agency under Indira Awas Yojana and by the Adi-Dravidar Welfare Department having a living space not exceeding 300 sq.ft. or 27.87 sq.mt. If any of the conditions is changed at a later stage, this concession of free supply will be discontinued and the consumer will have to take metered supply.

1	Name of Programme	<i>Agriculture Service for Small Farmers</i>
2	Type (Concession / Permits / Authorization)	Concession: - Power supply at free of cost.
3	Objective	To help the small farmers.
4	Targets set (For the last year)	Whoever applies for, the service will be effected.
5	Eligibility	Electricity will be supplied free of charge to small farmers whose families are solely dependent on the income derived from their agricultural land holding. A certificate to this effect from Revenue authority shall be produced for availing free power supply. "Small farmer means a person whose total holding, whether as owner, tenant or mortgaged with possession or partly in one capacity and partly in another, does not exceed two-and-a-half acres of wet lands or five acres of dry land. In computing the extent of land held by a person who holds both wet and dry lands, two acres of dry land shall be taken as equivalent to one acre of wet land.

7	Pre-requisites	The intending consumer shall obtain a Bonafide certificate from revenue Department stating that the applicant is a small farmer.
8	Procedure to avail the benefits	The intending consumer shall submit the duly filled application along with certificates from Revenue Department and copies of ownership documents to the concerned AE

		Office.
